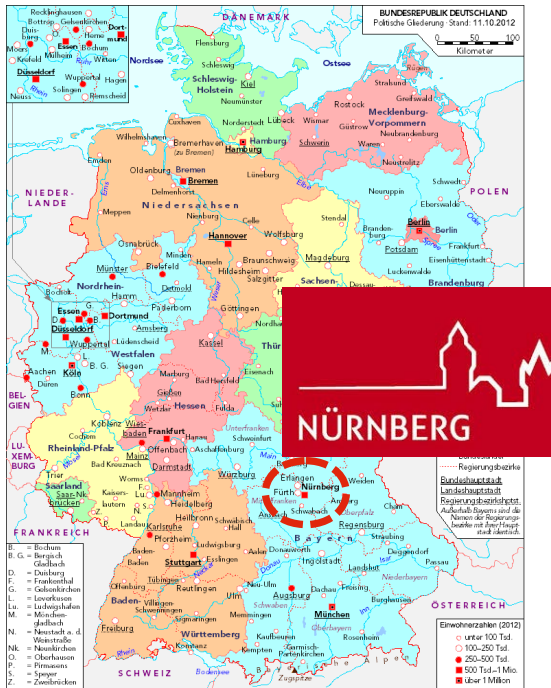

The Date 2016 TPC meeting venue is located in the city center of Nuremberg, very close to the historic district.



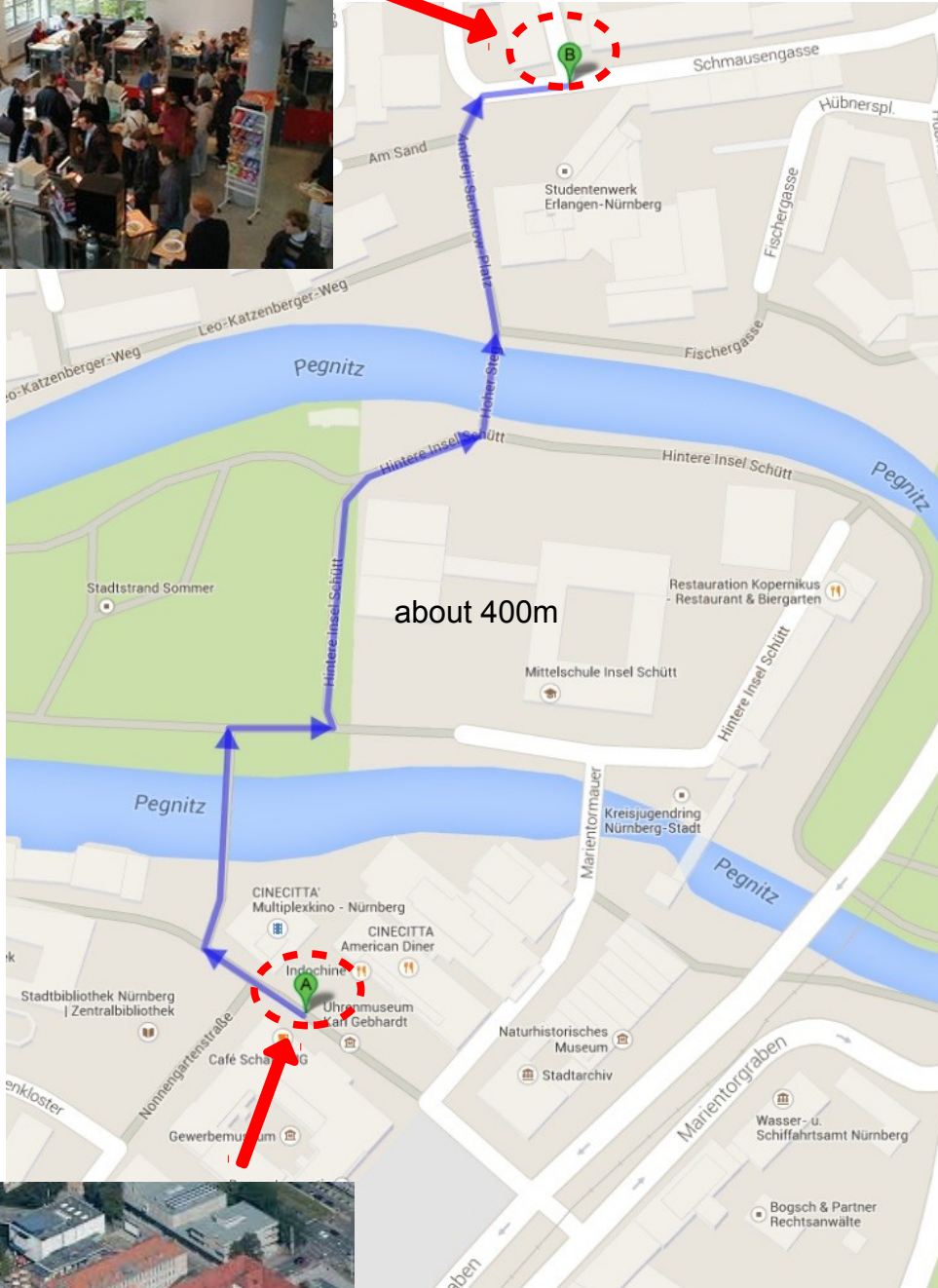
The venue is the historic building of the Nürnberger Akademie.

The registration for the TPC meeting is free of charge for DATE 2016 TPC members, but **it is mandatory to officially register** for logistic reasons.


